Appointments to the positions will be by majority vote of the Parish Council, at a meeting. Candidates may be invited to speak about themselves at this meeting.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be:

- A British Citizen, or a citizen of the Commonwealth.
- 18 years of age or over.
- A registered Elector for the parish
- In the past twelve months either:
 1. Lived in the parish, or within 3 miles of it
 2. Occupied, as owner or tenant, land or other premises in the parish.
 3. Been employed, as principal or only employment, within the parish.

Applicants cannot:

- Have been convicted of a crime within the past 5 years.
- Have been made bankrupt.
