8a - To receive an update on the Play Area Refurbishment Project - Cllr Coombes gave an update on the grant funding applications for the project. Some grant applications have had to be resubmitted and other applications are still being completed but all are progressing.

- 5. Borough and County Councillor Reports**
To receive Borough and County Cllr reports.
County Cllr Drew gave his report including updates on:
 - HCC Council Tax increase to be 4.995%
 - Devolution – HCC Consultation runs from 17 February to 13 April 2025. Mayor elections to take place in May 2026.
 - School places – over 90% pupils offered first choice of secondary school.

Update on flooding:

- Test Valley Borough Council will do a sweep.
- Cllr Drew spoke to local landowner about mud on the road.
- It was confirmed by residents that the drains are already blocked – Cllr Drew asked for photographs of blocked drains and locations to be sent to him to follow up with HCC.

Cllr Young will contact HCC to ask them to clear drains again.

To propose a response to be submitted to TVBC in relation to planning applications:

- a) 25/00427/TREES - G1 - 4 x Lime - Remove second stem (as per marked sketch plan), crown reduction by 2m and crown lift of 6m. T2 - Lime - Crown lift 8m, removing the first 3 branches back to source, and small eastern stem. T3 - Lime - Crown lift 6m, crown reduce top canopy back to pre-existing cuts (2m growth), reduce remaining crown by 1.5m – 11 Houghton Farm Close, Houghton – **Resolved - No Objection** – Proposed Cllr Adams, seconded Cllr Dougall, voted 3 for, 1 against – Proposal carried.
- b) Any other planning applications recently received.
The notification of application 25/00491/CLPS for a lawful development certificate was **noted**.
